Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated, is a private, not-for-profit organization whose purpose is to provide assistance and support through established programs in local communities throughout the world. Since its founding more than 200,000 women have joined the organization. The organization is a sisterhood of predominantly Black, college educated women. The sorority currently has 1,000 collegiate and alumnae chapters located in the United States, Japan (Tokyo and Okinawa), Germany, the Virgin Islands, Bermuda, the Bahamas, Jamaica, West Africa, Canada and the Republic of Korea. The major programs of the sorority are based upon the organization's Five-Point Programmatic Thrust. More than 10,000 members typically attend Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated's biennial national conventions, and each of the seven regional conferences (held during years when there is no national convention) typically hosts thousands of members. During the Centennial celebration, the 51st National convention, held in the District of Columbia, more than 38,000 members registered and attended.

Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated, an organization of college educated women committed to the constructive development of its members and to public service with a primary focus on the Black community.



For more than 53 years, the Indianapolis Alumnae Chapter (IAC) has awarded local scholarships to deserving young African American women in their senior year of high school, residing in Indianapolis, Kokomo, Zionsville, Avon, Brownsburg, Carmel, Greenwood, Fishers, Plainfield, Lafayette and West Lafayette. Scholarships are awarded based upon academic achievement, character, community service involvement, extracurricular activities, and financial need. Unfortunately, youth within our community continue to face financial barriers that prevent college access, retention, and matriculation. Thus, the importance and impact of educational fundraising and financial support is needed more now than ever before. Black College Tour (BCT)

The Indianapolis Alumnae Chapter Black College Tour has been a staple community resource for high school students for over 30 years. To date, this yearly program has provided over 1,400 students campus tours of more than 30 Historically Black Colleges and Universities in the South, East Coast and Midwest regions. Through the DST-IAC Black College Tour, students have an opportunity to visit nine to ten colleges and universities while on the tour. Our tour is touted by students and parents alike as a once in a lifetime opportunity many, which are from under-represented and/or under-served communities. During the BCT, students are able to communicate with administrators, admissions officers, current students, faculty, and staff, and even athletic coaches. Scholars can also explore scholarship opportunities, residence halls, extracurricular activities, and make college/university comparisons.

Dr. Betty Shabazz Delta Academy (Delta Academy)

Delta Academy is a national initiative serving girls ages 11-14. The Delta Academy aims to provide educational and enrichment activities at a critical development time in a young girl's life to promote and enhance positive development. A primary goal of the Delta Academy program is to prepare young girls for full participation as leaders in the 21st century. The program focuses on self-esteem, community service, educational achievement, leadership development, and physical & psychological well-being. Session topics include, but are not limited to: self-image, self-esteem, self-awareness, healthy body image, nutrition and fitness, career exploration, community action, and leadership development.

Dr. Jeanne L. Noble Delta G.E.M.S. Institute (Delta G.E.M.S.)

The Dr. Jeanne L. Noble Delta Gems (Growing & Empowering Myself Successfully) is a mentoring program for African-American girls in grades 9-12. The Delta GEMS Institute, a national flagship program for over 40 years exists to instill academic excellence, promote proper short and long-range goal setting and leadership skills. Additionally, GEMS seeks to create an understanding of compassion, caring, and community service. The Delta GEMS Institute participants are exposed to a myriad of opportunities which include educational workshops, community service projects, cultural events, college/university career choice sessions, social/ professional etiquette, self-esteem building, wellness, and financial management.

Indianapolis Alumnae Chapter Scholarships

For more than **53 years**, the Indianapolis Alumnae Chapter (IAC) has awarded scholarships to more than 200 African American high school senior girls. Scholarship recipients are residents of Indianapolis, Kokomo, and Lafayette. Scholarships are awarded based upon academic achievement and financial need. Scholarships range from \$500 to \$ 2,500 and are awarded annually. Additionally, the IAC Scholarship Committee also provides local chapter members, in pursuit of advanced degrees, an opportunity to apply for designated scholarships.
