

56th National Convention Frequently Asked Questions



These FAQs are intended to help members of the Host Chapter(s) navigate the planning process as we prepare for National Convention. Please check this site often for updates.

Convention Planning Volunteers

- Q: How do I get involved with a Convention Planning subcommittee?
- A: Currently, we are seeking Soror volunteers who are financial with IAC. Sorors can sign up following the process outlined on the 56th National Convention Information Page found on the IAC Sister's Only Portal. Additional volunteer opportunities will become available closer to convention.
- Q: Will sorors outside of IAC be allowed to volunteer?
- A: Yes! We will need all available hands to execute a successful National Convention. There will be opportunities for sorors not a member of the Host Chapters to volunteer on select committees.

*Convention Committee Volunteers will be solicited by Grand Chapter in the Spring.

- Q: What are the responsibilities of each subcommittee?
- A: Please visit the <u>56th National Convention Information Page</u> found on the IAC Sister's Only Portal for committee descriptions.
- Q: Can sorors volunteer for multiple committees?
- A: Yes, sorors can serve on more than one committee; however, we must be mindful of the time commitment required for each committee.

Convention Registration

- Q: When will registration open for the Host Chapters?
- A: As with previous practice, voting delegates will register prior to nonvoting delegates. Please continue to check the FAQs for updates related to onsite registration during the week of the convention.
- Q: Will members of the Host Chapters receive a registration discount?
- A: Please visit the **Call to Convention** for the registration rates for in person and virtual attendees.

Convention Store

- Q: When will the Convention Store be available?
- A: The Convention Store is scheduled to be available in April.
- Q: What items will be available in the Convention Store?
- A: Sorors can expect a robust shopping experience that will feature official Convention apparel.

- Q: What is the process for sorors to rent scooters during the Convention?
